USARA Change. Great news! We worked with USARA to allow all of you to race without having to purchase a license, yet your teams *will* still earn points in the USARA series.

- For teams that purchased single day licenses online, your accounts have been credited \$8/license.
- If you paid by check we'll have a refund for you at check-in on Saturday.
- For those who purchased annual licenses, we can still hook you up. There will be a waiver to sign on race day to order your license. If any of you pre-paid for an annual license and no longer want/need it, let me know and I'll run a refund through.

Check-in Changes.

One team member: Turn in a signed waiver for each team member and pick up your race packet and team goody bag. Waivers are available [online](#) – printing them and completing them ahead of time will save you time at registration. One waiver per racer. Team numbers have not been assigned yet, so you may leave that blank.

If you paid for an annual USARA license, the 3-part waiver/form will be in your racer materials, just fill it out and return to us before the end of day.

Canoe Rental.

Three-person teams if you are renting a canoe, please pay particular attention to this! I received this request from our boat vendor:

Please, please, please do not sit on the thwarts of the boats. First, the thwarts are not made for sitting, and none of us want to have to deal with a damaged boat. Second, sitting on the thwart puts your center of gravity way too high and the boat will be prone to tipping. It's icy out there folks, nobody wants to swim! Consider a cushion or another slightly raised object for your middle paddler's "comfort".
